

Pipeline Official Dies at 52

HOUSTON (AP)—Harris W. Van Zandt, 52, vice president of Transmission Pipeline Co., died Tuesday night of a heart attack.

A native of Fort Worth, Van Zandt was a former University of Texas football star.

Van Zandt joined a Houston law firm upon graduation at Texas and was assigned by the firm in 1940 as the Fort Worth attorney for Pure Oil Co. He resigned from the law firm in 1953 to become a vice president and director of Pure. He joined Transwestern in 1962.

Survivors include the widow, the former Dorothy Townes, Houston; a daughter, Mrs. Ronald G. Spence, Wichita, Kan., and two sons, John T. and William L. Van Zandt, Houston.

Funeral services will be held Thursday.
