## Folk Fest

A special note on the last two music-makers mentioned above:

The Red Crayola of Houston literally exploded onto the Festival scene, causing more controversy than any other group. RADICAL, BEAUTIFUL, MAD HIPPIE-SCIENTISTS, Genius?, RIDICULOUS, EVIL! Electronic Chance sound - music from guitars, a clarinet, an organ, a dripping ice block, mouth to mouth microphones, and on and on, sent sound through huge amps way beyond distortion levels and for some audience members, past the threshold of pain. Rick Barthelme, Steve Cunningham and Mayo Thompson create music without limits and admittedly that's difficult for as yet limited human heads to absorb. Yet their music screams freedom louder than any other, and to turn away is to attempt escape fr m...

Then there was love and Richie Havens. He is a 26 year old songwriter-singer-life lover with the countenance of an African guru, a WOW! - Jesus philosophy, and a guitar that's magic in E-chrd open tuning. He sent warm waves flowing all over the audience from his first appearance. He reinterprets Dylan, by syncope, until "Maggie's Farm" and "Just Like a Woman" are all his own. His own is a heady blend of jazz-folk-rock, and that's quite an achievement. Examples of his own Adam, High Flyin' Bird, to be found on his Verve Folkways album, "Mixed Bag". Berkeley may be still flying.
