worthwhile, just as television can be a worthwhile medium of expression and entertainment.

Kuralt's show is more of a history with fewer clips than is planned for the NBC effort.

NBC has dug up more of the old kinescopes and will have Lucille Ball, David Janssen, Michael Landon, Mary Martin, Dinah Shore and Red Skelton host segments of the two hours which will take a look at some of the talent which made television so exciting in those days.

The segments will be comedy (with clips of Groucho Marx, Jimmy Durante, Steve Allen, Jackie Gleason and other featured); westerns (such as Wyatt Earp, Gunsmoke, Bonanza, and The Rifleman); music (featuring Tony Bennett, Steve Lawrence, Perry Como, Tennessee Ernie Ford, Ethel Merman); situation comedy (with clips from shows like Ozzie and Harriet, My Three Sons, Andy Griffith, The Real McCoys, Mister Peepers, Sergeant Bilko, and Father Knows Best); ac-

tion dramas (such as The Fugitive, Perry Mason, Naked City, The Untouchables, 77 Sunset Strip, Peter Gunn); and dramatic and musical spectaculars (Peter Pan, Requiem for a Heavy

weight, Our Town, An Evening with Fred Astaire).

With a lineup like that, I can hardly wait for either show.

Even those among us who don't remember

the 50s (and there seems to be more and more of them these days) should enjoy this look back at entertainment which remains ageless and just as interesting today as it was then.


