# A taste of Scottish culture to be at Mo-Ranch Saturday

**HUNT** — Precision military movements and the lively ancestor of square dancing blend to preserve Scottish culture on the Guadalupe River bank at Mo-Ranch this Saturday afternoon.

Austin Scottish Country Dancers, performing to melodies from the Silver Thistle Pipes and drums of Austin is part of the Fourth Annual Days of the Scots, Friday through Sunday at Mo-Ranch.

The Scottish Country Dancers and Pipes and Drums join an events lineup highlighting Scotland that's open to the public beginning at 1 p.m. Saturday at Mo-Ranch riveride.

The Silver Thistle Pipes and Drums is directed by University of Texas engineering professor Kenneth Licht and promotes Scottish Highland Bagpiping and Drumming in Central Texas. Weekly practices at the university have built a growing organization devoted to Highland piping and snare drumming.

They'll be playing for the Austin Scottish Country Dancers. A forerunner of American square dancing, Scottish country dancing is Scotland's traditional ballroom dancing.

that revived this social dance from extinction in the early 20th century, said Sarah Harrison, with the dancers. Both the Silver Thistle Pipes and Drums and Austin Scottish Dancers are colorfully dressed, with the men in traditional kilts and the women wearing bright tartan sashes.

Other Saturday afternoon events include the complex and ancient Highland Dancing, sheep dog demonstrations and the chance to meet people from throughout Texas — and as far off as Scotland — who are devoted to preserving Scottish heritage.
