"Every time a leak like this occurs people get all uptight and bent out of shape," says Weatherly, who would not reveal how he got a copy of the album. "But the bottom line is we're here to do what we feel is the best thing for KROQ listeners, and a Pearl Jam release is a big event. We've earned a reputation for getting things early and we hope to do more in the future."

Epic Records executives were unavailable for comment.

Radio programmers couldn't have asked for a better Hanukkah present: the most-talked-about new album in rock, available only on the radio.

"It's great for radio to have a hit album that nobody can buy yet," says programming consultant Jeff Pollack.

WHO'S THAT GIRL?: We sneered two years ago when Courtney Love was quoted in Vanity Fair saying that she expected Madonna to steal her punkish look.

"I don't care how vain and arrogant this sounds, but just watch. . . . Madonna's going to have roots [showing], she's going to have smeared eyeliner," Love said. "And that's me. . . . She wants my image."

Madonna spokeswoman Liz Rosenberg acknowledges that a lot of people have mistaken the photo for Love, but says that Madonna is not guilty of copying Love's look.

"It's not like this was the first time she had smeared eyeliner or roots showing," Rosenberg says, noting that in an upcoming video Madonna has an entirely different look that's nothing like Love's.

It's R.E.M. month for **Tori Amos**. She's teaming with **Michael Stipe** to record a new song for the soundtrack to "Don Juan DeMarco" (starring Johnny Depp, Marlon Brando and Faye Dunaway), and is also recording her own version of R.E.M.'s "Losing My Religion" for director John Singleton's "Higher Learning." . . .

Soundgarden's **Chris Cornell** and Latin pop star **Shena** have also recorded songs for "Don Juan." The album is due Feb. 14. . . .

The U.S. version of former Pogues singer **Shane MacGowan's** solo debut album, "The Snake," will feature a duet with **Sinead O'Connor** on a song titled "Haunted." The album is credited to Shane MacGowan & the Popes and will be in stores here on Feb. 14. The duet is not on the just-released British version. . . .

Sparks' first British concert in 17 years on Nov. 17 had an all-star audience, including **Morrissey**, **Depeche Mode's Martin Gore** and **Erasure's Vince Clarke**, while former Suede guitarist **Bernard Butler** joined the group onstage for three songs. Sparks, now just brothers Ron and Russell Mael and a percussionist, will release its first album in six years in the spring. . . .

In other comeback news, **Boston** will hit the road in May for its first tour since 1986. . . . The debut album by **Wilco**, featuring former members of Uncle Tupelo, is due in March. . . .

The Dec. 17 concert by blues veteran **Johnny (Guitar) Watson** at B.B. King's Blues Club in Universal City will be broadcast live nationally on ABC radio's "Touch Network." The L.A. outlet is to be determined.
