Light up your life

The role lighting plays in your home should be, well, illuminating.

But most houses have too few lights that are lit at a much higher intensity than is needed even for reading, according to interior designer Alan H. Garren.

The result is lots of glare and discomfort. Light sources that are much brighter than their surroundings will cause discomfort.

A couple of lamps and a couple of three-way bulbs. That's how many people view lighting, said Garren, of Garren-McCuan Interiors Inc. of Akron, Ohio.

Correct lighting first focuses on practicality. Is the lighting in your rooms and stairwells sufficient for safe movement?

A useful exercise is to walk around your house at dusk both inside and out, wrote Derek Phillips, a lighting and architectural consultant for more than 20 years, in his book, "Planning Your Lighting."

In the reduced light, Phillips said, areas of special danger soon will become apparent.

He added that what may appear relatively easy and safe to an adult in good health could seem quite different to an elderly person with poor eyesight or to a youngster who awakens in the night.

Generally, lighting falls into three categories: Background, task and decorative.

Background and task lighting are the most important. Ceiling and wall fixtures and lamps provide background illumination needed for safe movement and for doing some jobs.
