

Rock Trio, Folksinger To Perform

A concert by The Mandrake Memorial and Townes Van Zandt will be held at 8:15 p.m. Wednesday in Wait Chapel on the campus of Wake Forest University.

The concert is sponsored by the university radio station WFDD, and Phi Mu Alpha, a music fraternity. The concert is open to the public, and tickets are being sold through the radio station, Bocoek Stroud, and Reznick's. Proceeds from the concert will go toward the station's and fraternity's musical projects.

The Mandrake Memorial is a rock trio recording on the Poppy label. Its members are 19 to 21 years old. The name comes from the mandrake, a root reputed to have magical powers.

Van Zandt is a Texas folk-singer-poet, who also records for Poppy.
