Student art and science projects will be on display all day. The photojournalism entries in the 2001 competition will be on display.

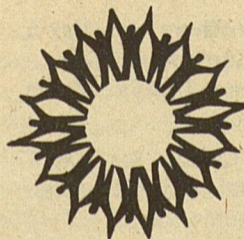

These films and slide/tape presentations will be shown continuously in both rooms. Exact times of showings for each film or presentation will be posted outside each of the rooms.

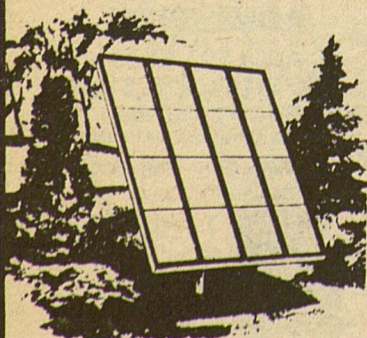

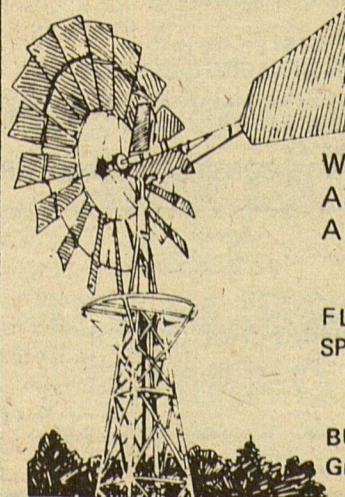
