

New Austin Music Festival in April

AUSTIN — The new, three-day, five-concert Stroh's Celebrate Austin Music Festival scheduled for Austin's Auditorium Shores on April 13, 14 & 15 has announced the full line-up and mail orders for tickets.

Produced by Kerrville Festival producer Rod Kennedy, a former resident and producer of more than 500 events in Austin prior to his move to Kerrville 10 years ago, the festival is co-sponsored by the Austin Parks & Recreation Department and will provide Austin fans and visitors with the chance to hear 22 of Austin's top artists in one place on one weekend for an advance discount ticket price of only \$15.

Eighteen other Austin artists are featured on pre-festival concerts at Austin's Symphony Square on the 10th, 11th & 12th, but advance tickets will not be available for these concerts as they are expected to sell out to local sponsors and investors.
