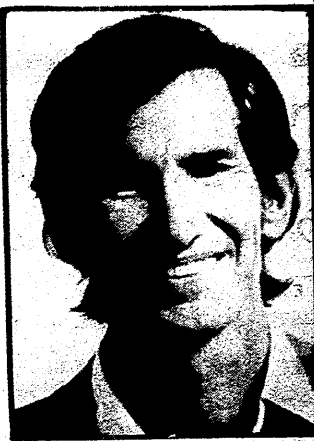


Blues, jazz and rock lead the weekend line-up
