BO DIDDLEY

All systems are go for the 1991 Music City Blues Fest. Promoters are billing the event as "Battle of the Legends," for it co-stars Rock 'n' Roll Hall of Famer **Bo Diddley** and rhythm-and-blues monarch **Johnny Taylor**.

Bo Diddley's famed rhythms and wry songwriting style fused blues sass and rock kick in the 1950s and he has remained a headliner ever since. Taylor's songs range from the rootsy *Who's Makin' Love* to the mega-hit *Disco Lady*. Blues veteran **Bobby Rush** joins them on the bill with such classic numbers as *Sock It to Me* and *What's Good for the Goose* is

bum *Harp Attack* and he has the reputation as one of the blues field's most exciting young showmen.

Nashville's **Sandra Wright & Soul Kitchen, Johnny Jones & the Imperials** and the **Nationals** round out the bill. The great **Hoss Allen** will host the festival.

The event takes place 4 p.m.-midnight at the new Park West Outdoor Arena, 3940 Clarksville Highway Saturday. Tickets are \$15.50 in advance from Ticketmaster or \$20 at the gate. Seating is festival-style, so bring lawn chairs or blankets. Picnic baskets are allowed and food vendors will be on site.
