GUY CLARK/PETER ROWAN/ JOHN STEWART/TOWNES VAN ZANDT: Something of a dream bill for fans of the tougher end of country-folk-rock: four legends on one bill. Clark, from Texas and featured on last Saturday's Arena epic, is quite a regular visitor these days, still turning out songs that seem like old friends as soon as you hear them; Peter Rowan's Free Mexican Airforce and Panama Red have been aptly described as "alternative anthems"; John Stewart is still best-known for penning Daydream Believer but has consistently turned out nifty tunes; while the formerly-reclusive Townes Van Zandt's Poncho And Lefty must be one of the most-recorded songs ever written. It will run for at least 31/2 hours. Be there on time. (Centre Stage, Romiley Forum, Compstall Road, 7 30pm, £10).
